

1 15 MS. MORRIS: Hi. I just found out about this
16 meeting today via the radio. And my comments are, one,
17 you really should put a sign out front where the meeting
18 is because I was up in the upper level trying to get in.

2 19 I don't think any state should take the brunt
20 of all the nuclear waste from the world because that's
21 eventually what it is going to lead up to, if anybody has
22 their will about it.

3 23 I think we ought to take our biotechnology
24 companies that are doing an immense amount of work in
25 trying to change things that are working perfectly well,
1 for instance, our food supply, and stop trying to alter
2 the food supply and work with trying to make something of
3 the nuclear waste that exists with the biotechnology
4 that's available, and I'm sure that that is possible.

4 5 I also think that the nuclear waste should
6 stay where it is right now. It's been residing in those
7 locations for quite a few years. Nothing harmful has
8 happened regarding that place of residence. And so to
9 transport it only really throws in another element of
10 danger.

5 11 I think that the corporations that profit by
12 creating nuclear waste should be totally responsible for
13 doing the research that it's going to take to correct the
14 situation, and that means that needs to filter all the way
15 down to the shareholders.

16 And if they are municipalities that are

...5 17 involved, they, too, usually have shareholders, and if
18 those shareholders happen to be the citizens of the cities
19 where the municipalities serve, then they need to be
20 responsible for that.
