17 think was in the plan to transfer the waste about a half a mile
18 out of Caliente or a quarter of a mile, maybe. It wasn't very
19 far, and I don't think that's a very good idea.

20 It seems to me it should be put on -- if they're
21 going to do it that way to transfer it in a safe spot away from
22 a populated area, and that was the main thing I wanted to say
23 tonight.]
