Comments: Dear Ms. Wendy Dixon,

1 I realize that the depth of my understanding the complexities of the nuclear waste problem is limited, however sometimes the very people working on a project cannot see the forest for the trees. This holds true for the proposed Yuca Mountain Project. My concern lies not with the safety of Yuca Mountain as a disposal site but with the transportation of the high-level radioactive waste.

After reading the NEI fact sheet and policy brief the one glaring fact stands out- monetary savings justifies this plan and the potential for accidents causing harm to the individuals and environment along the projected routes are within the acceptable casualty range.

My children and grandchildren are living in the Cleveland Ohio area and their lives are at risk.

2 It would make more sense to contain the waste at the creation site and develop alternate energy sources. According to the policy brief nuclear energy is only responsible for 20% of the electricity the country uses.

Please reconsider carefully and look at the full ramifications of such a project.
