

Dear Ms. Dixon:

- 1 I am writing to express my strong opposition to the Department of Energy's proposal to store high-level radio-active waste at the Yucca Mountain in Nye County, NV. If this proposal is approved, the storage of high-level radioactive waste at Yucca Mountain could irreparably harm the aquifer in Death Valley National Park and the Amargosa
- 2 Valley, and threaten humans and wildlife which depend on that water. I also wish to express my opposition to the DOE's proposal to ship high-level nuclear waste to the site via Highway 127, right through Tecopa and Shosone.

I urge the Department of Energy to withdraw this proposal for the sake of the safety of humans and wildlife which could be threatened by these actions.
