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02 MS. LESTER: Grace Lester.

03 FACILITATOR HOLMES: All right. You know, major  
04 league baseball players hit 280, and I am batting zero.

05 MS. LESTER: That's all right. My name is Grace  
06 Lester, PO 106, Yucaipa, California. If anybody is  
07 asleep, wake up. Okay. So I watched you kind of  
08 snoring away.

09 The ethnic cleansing of American people has  
10 already started. Whether you like to admit it or not,  
11 it is here. My nephew has had a whole heart  
12 transplant. We settled in Barstow area. And you want  
13 to see something about toxic waste, you see how many  
14 people are left from the PGE disaster, and the only ones  
15 that collected money were the ones that were involved in  
16 the medical field that knew what was what, and not the  
17 average citizen.

18 Because any lawsuits will be continued in any  
19 way, shape or form, until most of the people are dead.  
20 Now, to substantiate my --

21 AUDIENCE MEMBER: What was the accident? Would you  
22 say it again?

23 MS. LESTER: PG & E.

24 FACILITATOR HOLMES: Sir, don't slow her down.

25 MS. LESTER: The ethnic cleansing goes on, and yet  
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01 it is being ignored. Politicians are only interested in  
02 what they can make out of the deals. Senator Baca, a  
03 while back in 1996, they tampered with his vote so he  
04 could be elected. He came from the Barstow area. Is it  
05 any wonder that veterans are dying at the veterans' home  
06 up there?

07 Jon Mikels, along with Joan Kamanski -- these  
08 are leaders -- elite, high-type leaders. They used to  
09 mix toxic waste with manure and put it on public  
10 grounds. How safe are your school children after that  
11 toxic waste was put on their school grounds? Or on golf  
12 courses or under public buildings?

13 The Indian people, I have to give them a lot of

14 credit, and I have three children that are part  
15 Cherokee. The Indian people, the Mohawk, the Amandaga,  
16 the Iroquois -- they started protesting in the 1950's  
17 and 1960's. Here we are in California, all of these  
18 problems are being shoved underneath the mat. It is not  
19 just about Indian people; it is about all people,  
20 because we are Americans.

21 The cleansing -- the cleansing of American  
22 people and the hate crimes -- all politicians -- towards  
23 these American people is a criminal act under Federal  
24 law, and they should be apprehended and jailed. But we  
25 find that these elite groups are not jailed because we  
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01 live in a oligarchy, not a democracy. We are being  
02 governed by a government of the few.

03 When my child or my nephews had a full heart  
04 transplant -- or anybody that goes to a hospital, they  
05 ask you, do you have medical care? No, we don't. We  
06 are low income. Who is going to take time to heal a low  
07 income person? So we are ethnically being cleansed.  
08 China is not concerned about how they are going to store  
09 their toxic waste. Governor Clinton -- I mean President  
10 Clinton, Wilson, Jon Mikels, Jerry Eaves, all of these  
11 political leaders in this era met up in Sacramento with  
12 Supreme Court Justice Ronald George to quietly let toxic  
13 waste come into this country.

14 You know, China has eradicated, with a smile,  
15 all over the world, different ethnic groups. So here is  
16 a dinkly-wink Clinton going over and expecting the  
17 Chinese government to put this toxic waste in places  
18 where we will not be hurt. I mean, this is ridiculous.  
19 We are bringing toxic waste from South America. It has  
20 been on Channel 28 and any of your educational  
21 channels.

22 And they show how children are being born; they  
23 showed the corruption in government going on.

24 FACILITATOR HOLMES: One more minute.

25 MS. LESTER: Okay. One more minute? The scientific

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01 community is not working world-wide to eliminate toxic  
02 waste. Clinton and all of these people met in  
03 Sacramento to kill American people. Jon Mikels and  
04 them, they did all of this -- our community leaders who  
05 have done a crime to American citizens are not going to  
06 jail, but Jeff Wright went for speaking three minutes  
07 over -- I mean, a minute over. I was jailed, because I  
08 stood up for Jeff. Jerry Eaves told him since he didn't  
09 have a job, and that he wasn't paying taxes, that he  
10 didn't see why he was even voicing a comment in public  
11 in a public building. So we have an elected official  
12 telling the American citizens you have no right to speak  
13 the truth because it would hurt all of these people.

14           The judges are in on it, nationwide. We have  
15 the Supreme Court justices picked by Clinton. They were  
16 put in place because any time a common, every-day  
17 citizen goes and complains, the judge either throws it  
18 out or else he's getting a kickback from someone.

19           Our families are being disbanded like in  
20 Gestapo times, or killed. Wake up. How many of us will  
21 live to see any day of these people going to jail? Look  
22 what happened. He laundered millions and millions of  
23 dollars, and you can't touch his retirement fund. You  
24 can't touch any of the monies that he's taken.

25           We are an oligarchy; we are not a democracy.

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01 We are governed by the few. When the constitution was  
02 written, it was written for the few, by the few to  
03 profit the few, and not the common every-day citizen.

04           There is no such law in the constitution  
05 against rape, molestation, or any of these crimes  
06 because the plantation owners themselves were doing  
07 that.

08           FACILITATOR HOLMES: If you can finish up.

09           MS. LESTER: I'm done.
