Eight comments were Faxed July 4 to what I thought was DOE's Fax 1-800-967-0739; however, the responding fax machine phone number was 702-295-5222. Please confirm that DOE received my important comments on the SDEIS for Yucca Mountain.

Additional comments are:

1) I request the Public Comment period on the SDEIS for all the public, not just a special few, be extended to match the Public Comment Period for the Science and Engineering Report. Combined Public Hearing on both these report should be held with adequate time for the public to speak. The five minutes at the Las Vegas meeting was inadequate. As a minimum, everyone should be allow to the new August 13,2001. DOE notice should be published, by DOE paid ads of one-half page, in all the Regional Newspapers in Nevada and along the Transportation Routes.

2) Transportation of four shipments a day for 24 years is too many not to be address as a major PROJECT ELEMENT that needs to be fully designed in the DEIS. There are major omissions for Transportation in the original DEIS that have not been coorrected by the SDEIS. As a minimum, a SUPPLEMENT DEIS on the details of the TRANSPORTATION Plan must be prepared to address all the public comments to date. A Public Comment period and Public Hearing shall be held in Las Vegas and All major impacted Population Centers and communities.

Good environmental Engineering requires that the major public concern area be professional addressed not just swept under the rug with the excuse that the site

has not be selected!
